FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 - INFORMATION REQUEST

Your request for information has been considered under the requirements of the Freedom of Information Act and our response is as follows:

Do the staff from the PRC at the University's Confucius Institute have to abide by Chinese law on campus? The University is not privy to the contracts that staff have signed with the University of Science and Technology Beijing in China before joining the Confucius Institute at De Montfort University, therefore, this is not information we hold.

Has the University entered into agreements that demand as much? No.

Article 1 in the 2020 signed agreement (which was previously released to you under FOI Reference 1914) states:

The Confucius Institute at De Montfort University, which is a China-United Kingdom cooperation project, shall serve the purpose of Confucius Institute, operate according to the laws and regulations of England and Wales and under the jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
