No. UCLan's agreement with the Confucius Institute Headquarters states:

Chinese citizens involved in activities of the Institute shall be subject to the laws and policies of University of Central Lancashire and Britain. British citizens involved in activities of the Institute in China shall be subject to the laws and policies of China.
