Thank you for your request made under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (Fol(S)A) for the following information from the University of Dundee.

Your request and our response:

Please provide a list of all financial interactions between the university and its subsidiary institutions and the Chinese Students and Scholars Association (CSSA). IE, please provide a list of funding provided to the CSSA.

We note that there are no dates specified on this request, so we have reviewed our records since August 2019 when our current finance system went live.

The Chinese Students and Scholars Association (CSSA) is not set up as a supplier/creditor in our purchase ledger so there have been no payments through this route. We have also checked for payments made by purchasing card and have not identified any such payments.

We have checked with other relevant departments and they have no records. Therefore, under Fol(S)A, we are applying the exemption S.17 (Information not held).
