*We have reviewed our Financial Records, and I can confirm that no payments have been made to the CSSA by the University during the period requested.*

*We also feel it necessary to highlight that the CSSA is not a part of the University of Nottingham, it is a society within the Students' Union, which is an independent body and not a subsidiary of the University.*
