Professor Guo left Imperial College London in 2022 to take up the role of Provost at the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (HKUST). He no longer has an association with Imperial.

Thank you for your response. However, I am not satisfied with it. I helped work on the Channel 4 Dispatches documentary, which featured investigation of Guo and DSI. I understand that the claim you are now making - that Guo "left Imperial College London in 2022" - was never communicated to the team working on Dispatches. This seems rather odd. Rather, Imperial replied to inquiries about Guo and his work with reference to staff codes of practice, somewhat implying Guo was still associated with Imperial/DSI.

Moreover, as I have made clear, Guo was listed as the director of DSI until after the documentary aired late last year (2023). His biography also appeared on Imperial's website until recently. And Guo seemingly continues to refer to his affiliation with DSI on his publications (as of late least year - see https://scholar.google.com/citations? hl=en&user=-0q6clYAAAAJ&view op=list works&sortby=pubdate)

Of course, Guo was associated with Shanghai University whilst at Imperial - and it is perfectly possible for a scholar to have more than one affiliation. So becoming Provost at HKUST does not exclude a continuing role at DSI/Imperial.

When did Guo cease to work in any capacity as director or co-director of the Data Science Institute? When did his role at DSI formally end?

When did Guo lose his staff privileges at Imperial?

These are really very simple questions that should not in any way be sensitive.

Thank you. It strikes me that something is being obscured here. You explain that Guo "left" Imperial & DSI in 2022, but you do not state that that was when his "association" with Imperial and DSI ended. Rather, you simply state that it "has" now ended. You also state that there exists information that you *cannot* tell me - with reference to personal data laws. It strikes me then that I should summarise Imperial's formal response as follows:

Question: When did Guo cease to work in any capacity as director or co-director of the Data Science Institute? When did his role at DSI formally end?

Response: "the information that you are requesting is personal data relating to an individual's contract, which we are not able to disclose."

When did Guo lose his staff privileges at Imperial?
