**For all requested years: The University, via the Chengdu University of Technology Oxford Brookes College, has not allocated an annual budget to any affiliated Chinese Communist Party branch of Chengdu University of Technology.**

- *Total annual expenditure spent by the Chengdu University of Technology Oxford Brookes College's Chinese Communist Party branch during the years 2015-2023.*

**For all requested years: The University does not hold records for any annual expenditure spent by the Chengdu University of Technology's Chinese Communist Party branch. Such records would be held by the Chengdu University of Technology itself.**
