 - · Total annual budgets allocated to its directly-affiliated Chinese Communist Party branches by the Joint Educational Institutes during the years 2015-2023 respectively.
 - · Total annual expenditures spent by the Joint Educational Institutes' Chinese Communist Party branches during the years 2015-2023 respectively.

The sought information is vital for assessing how public resources are managed in contexts influenced by the Chinese Communist Party.
