I write on behalf of the University of Leicester in response to your request, received 11<sup>th</sup> April 2024, made under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Your request and the University's response:

*This is a Freedom of Information request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Please provide the following information:*

· *Total annual budget allocated to its directly-affiliated Chinese Communist Party branch by the Leicester International Institute during the years 2015-2023.*

· *Total annual expenditure spent by the Leicester International Institute's Chinese Communist Party branch during the years 2015-2023.*

The University of Leicester does not hold the requested information. This is because the University does not provide financial support to, or hold records for the Chinese Communist Party and the University is advising you of this as required by Section 1(1) of the FOI Act, which requires public authorities to confirm or deny that they hold information requested.
