I refer to your Freedom of Information request regarding the annual budget allocated to and the annual expenditure spent by Chengdu University's Chinese Communist Party branch. The responses to your questions are below:

Total annual budget allocated to its directly-affiliated Chinese Communist Party branch by the Stirling College (Chengdu) during the years 2015-2023.

The University does not spend any public money on any aspects of the operation at Chengdu University Stirling College directly or indirectly affiliated Chinese Communist Party. We simply invoice Chengdu University for the agreed share of tuition fees, not public resources, collected from the students taking our programme.

Total annual expenditure spent by the Stirling College (Chengdu)'s Chinese Communist Party branch during the years 2015-2023.

Please see the above response.

You have a right under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FoISA) to request a review of this decision by the University of Stirling. If you wish to exercise this right, you must write to the University to request a review within forty working days of receipt of this decision. Your request for a review must be in writing and you must specify your name and address for correspondence. You must also identify the decision that you wish reviewed.

If you are dissatisfied with the outcome of a review, you have a right under the FoISA to appeal to the Scottish Information Commissioner. If you wish to do so, you must appeal to the Commissioner within six months following the date of receipt of the review notice. Details on how to appeal to the Scottish Information Commissioner are available on their website www.itspublicknowledge.info/Appeal. You also have the right to appeal to the Court of Session on a point of law following a decision of the Commissioner.
