QMUL's establishment of academic projects or partnerships or funding with external institutions or individuals have significant commercial sensitivity and disclosure would likely prejudice our commercial interests by putting QMUL in a more competitive market and a weaker negotiation position.

QMUL recognises the legitimate public interest in the transparency of higher education institutes. In balancing the public interest, we consider the greater benefit to the UK as a whole. Disclosing whether or not we have applied for any UK Export Licence and the details pertaining to this, could affect the free and fair competition of QMUL business in an open market. On balance we believe that the public interest in withholding the information outweighs the public interest in disclosing the information.
