#### **COMPLAINT RIGHTS**

Are you unhappy with how your request has been handled or do you think the decision is incorrect?

You have the right to require Manchester Metropolitan University to review their decision.

Prior to lodging a formal complaint you are welcome and encouraged to discuss the decision with the case officer that dealt with your request.

# Ask to have the decision looked at again

The quickest and easiest way to have the decision looked at again is to contact the case officer.

That person will be able to discuss the decision, explain any issues and assist with any problems.

# Request for Internal Review

If you are dissatisfied with the handling procedures or the decision of Manchester Metropolitan University made under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 regarding access to information, you can request to have the decision reviewed.

Internal review requests should be made in writing to foi@mmu.ac.uk, stating the reason you believe the response should be reviewed. You must appeal within 40 working days of the date of this email. Under s5.3 of the Freedom of Information Act Code of Practice, we are not obliged to accept appeals/internal reviews after this date.

- · Total annual expenditure spent by the Manchester Metropolitan Joint Institute's Chinese Communist Party branch during the years 2015-2023.

The sought information is vital for assessing how public resources are managed in contexts influenced by the Chinese Communist Party. Should the university not directly hold the requested information, I kindly ask for guidance on the appropriate entity or partner institution that does, ensuring compliance and facilitating informed public discourse on these matters.
