**You requested the following information:**

Please provide the following information:

- From 2015 to 2023, the numbers of Middlesex University London degrees (including all Bachelor and Master) conferred every year at the Middlesex College of Minzu University of China. Please provide this information in aggregated numbers by different programmes.
- Lists of education programmes, research projects, and research grants that are currently operational at Middlesex College of Minzu University of China, either participated by Middlesex College of Minzu University of China students and staff or sponsored by the Middlesex College of Minzu University of China and the Middlesex University London.
- Middlesex University London policies and governance structure which oversee the operations, including student experience and research, at the Middlesex College of Minzu University of China. Please provide relevant policy documents and/or relevant administrative staff role specifications where applicable.
- From 2015 to 2023, donations, grants, and research fundings received by the Middlesex University London and its affiliated entities from the Minzu University of China and/or any affiliated individuals, companies, or relevant Chinese official agencies.

**The University's response**

We have not conferred any degrees yet as the joint institute has only just launched.; We have four Undergraduate programmes and one Postgraduate. The staffing so far has been simply an administrative post (through the University's China office) and we have staff providing the English Language tuition.

There are no donations, grants or research income.

## **Your Right to Request a University Review of the Response**

- (II) To reverse it; or
- (III) To modify it.

If you remain dissatisfied with the outcome of the review, you may complain to the Information Commissioner's Office.
