Freedom of Information Act 2000 Request

Further to your email dated 28 March 2024 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, the University has considered your request. You sought the following information:

1. Total annual budget allocated to its directly-affiliated Chinese Communist Party branch by the University of Nottingham Ningbo China during the years 2015-2023.

2.Total annual expenditure spent by the University of Nottingham Ningbo China's Chinese Communist Party branch during the years 2015-2023.

The University of Nottingham does not hold this information. The University of Nottingham, Ningbo would process these fees should they exist, and the UK Freedom of Information Act does not cover the operations for the University of Nottingham, Ningbo in China where this is not held by the University of Nottingham.

The University has responded to the questions raised within your FOIA request. If you feel that the University has misunderstood your request in any way or you are dissatisfied with the response to your request, you can request an internal review by contacting info-requests@nottingham.ac.uk within 40 working days of the date of this response.

You also have the right, under Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to apply to the Information Commission for a decision as to whether your request for information has been dealt with in accordance with the requirements of Part 1 of the FOIA. The Commissioner will, however, normally require you to pursue an internal appeal to the University prior to considering such an application.
