- Total annual expenditure spent by the Lancaster University College's Chinese Communist Party branch during the years 2015-2023.

The sought information is vital for assessing how public resources are managed in contexts influenced by the Chinese Communist Party. Should the university not directly hold the requested information, I kindly ask for guidance on the appropriate entity or partner institution that does, ensuring compliance and facilitating informed public discourse on these matters.
