REQUEST 1

From 2015 to 2023, the numbers of Birmingham City University degrees (including all Bachelor and Master) conferred every year at the Birmingham Institute of Fashion and Creative Art, Wuhan Textile University. Please provide this information in aggregated numbers by different programmes.

RESPONSE

This information can be obtained from the Aggregate Offshore Return from HESA.

Information regarding student numbers is collated and submitted to the Higher Education Statistical Agency ('HESA'). This information can be accessed publicly on the HESA website, see the following website link: https://www.hesa.ac.uk/data-and-analysis In addition to information available publicly on the HESA website, HESA can provide custom extracts and reports regarding data on student numbers. A custom request is likely to be chargeable. HESA will be able to advise you on what information is publicly available and what information would carry a fee. Under section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act we do not have to provide information which is otherwise reasonably accessible, this is the case even if it is only accessible on payment of a fee.

Information up to the academic year of 21/22 is currently available from HESA. Information for the academic year of 22/23 and 23/24 will be available for future publication once returns for these academic years have been verified. Therefore your request should be directed to HESA. They will advise you on what can be accessed free of charge and or what reports or information would be chargeable. With regards to the 2023/24 data, we do not provide in-year data as it is commercially sensitive. Data for the 2023/24 academic year will be available for future publication from HESA, once the figures have been submitted, finalised and verified. Any data which is intended for future publication but that has not yet been published, is exempt from disclosure under section 22 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The information you have requested will be accessible when it is published in January 2025 and therefore it is reasonable to wait for this publication date to allow the data to be collected, finalised and appropriately verified.

REQUEST 2

Lists of education programmes, research projects, and research grants that are currently operational at Birmingham Institute of Fashion and Creative Art, either participated by Birmingham Institute of Fashion and Creative Art students and staff or sponsored by the Birmingham Institute of Fashion and Creative Art and the Birmingham City University.

RESPONSE

Birmingham Institute of Fashion and Creative Art is a separate legal entity and joint institute. Such information is not solely held by BCU and is therefore not covered by the scope of the request. We are unable to confirm on the research projects and research grants currently operational at Birmingham Institute of Fashion and Creative Art as they are a separate organisation to BCU.
